## The Question: How can I live out my life-purpose?

2. What did Jesus mean "of all nations?" How can we, in the great metropolis of Merced, give ourselves to this vision? What is the next step for you personally to continue to grow in doing this?
3. Why do you personally want to join his mission of making disciples of all nations? What hinders you these days from doing so?

2. How does that make you feel?
