What part of this sermon stuck out to you the most? Why?

God brought the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt and was in the process of bringing them to the Promise Land. Along the journey they disobeyed God and faced many consequences. During the journey they complained to God and Moses about how hard the journey was and that they would be better off on their own. In the midst of their disobedience God was faithful to bring them to the Promise Land as promised. God showed his mercy by making provisions for them.

Which aspect of the Israelites responses relates to you the most? Do you complain about your circumstances and where God has you? (Philippians 2:14-15). Do you sometimes think you would be better following your own plans?
