1. In 1 Peter 1:1, Peter speaks of the elect exiles. Based on what we talked about on Sunday morning, who does this term refer to?
2. In verse 2, we see the beauty community of the Trinity at work. What are the roles of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit as pointed out by Peter?
3. In verse 3, Peter says out of the Father's great mercy came what incredible gift to mankind?
4. What is our living hope as seen in verse 3?
5. What is the inheritance that comes out of our living hope?
6. Peter says that our hope of our inheritance will not fade, will not perish, and will not be defiled. How does this promise encourage your soul?
7. Peter talks about the fact that during our trials, we are to rejoice because they bring about the tested genuineness of our faith. In what ways have you seen the trials of your life bring about the genuineness of your faith?
8. In verses 13-25, Peter speaks about the call to be holy. How does Peter define holy living?
9. Based upon Peter definition, how would you define holy living for your daily life?
10. One of the processing points mentioned, was the call for us as a Church to work on the connection between the knowledge of our head and how it settles in our hearts. How is this process going in your life? How can you grow in this process?
