1. Is there anything that particularly stood out to you from this passage or this message? Explain.

Consider the claim.

35 The next day again John was standing with two of his disciples, 36 and he looked at Jesus as he walked by and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God!" 37 The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus.

2. What do you think it meant for these disciples that Jesus is the "Lamb of God"?
3. What does it mean to you?
4. How does it make you feel that Jesus frees you from death by His sacrifice?

Ask the all-important question.

38 Jesus turned and saw them following and said to them, "What are you seeking?" And they said to him, "Rabbi" (which means Teacher), "where are you staying?" 39 He said to them, "Come and you will see." So they came and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day, for it was about the tenth hour.

5. What do you think Jesus meant by asking, "what are you seeking?"
6. What would be your answer today?
7. What does it mean for you personally to "come and see?"
8. How are you doing that these days?

Love to tell the simple Gospel.

40 One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. 41 He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which means Christ).

9. Why do you think Andrew went and told his brother, Simon, about Jesus?
10. What was his message to Simon? What do you think that meant to Simon?
11. What is the simple message that people need to hear today?
12. What is the next step for you in telling this news?

Listen to what Jesus says about you.

42 He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "So you are Simon the son of John? You shall be called Cephas" (which means Peter).

13. Why do you think Jesus changed Simon's name? How do you think that made Simon feel?
14. In thinking about what Jesus says about you, what especially challenges, comforts or encourages you these days? Why?
