Keep in mind His Sovereignty

1. Considering that Jesus knew what was about to happen to Him in Jerusalem, how does that make you feel that He still went?
2. Why do you think Jesus chose to use his disciples to do something so strange as go untie a colt that doesn't belong to them and bring it to Him? What was He trying to teach them? How has God taught you the same thing?
3. How are you experiencing God's sovereignty in your life these days?

Ignite a passion for Obedience

1. That God knows the outcome... does that make obedience easier for you personally? Explain.
2. Consider John 10:10. How does this verse help you to obey God? What other verses do you think of that help you to choose to obey God?
3. Would you agree from your own experience that obedience ALWAYS brings the best results? Explain.

Notice his works and Celebrate

1. When verse 37 refers to "*all of the mighty works that they had seen*" what comes to your mind?
2. What mighty works has He done in your life?
3. What does it mean to you personally these days that Jesus is King of Kings and Lord of Lords? How would you like to live differently even this week in response?

Gear up for opposition

1. We live in a world full of people who oppose Jesus. Why is recognizing this reality helpful to your own spiritual life?
2. Read Matthew 7:13-14. What does it mean to you personally these days to "*take the narrow road*"?
